MEMORANDUM FOR 6th MLMC Soldiers

SUBJECT: Welcome Letter

1. Welcome to the 6th Medical Logistics Management Center (MLMC). The 6th MLMC is a unique, one-of-a-kind unit in the Army and the Department of Defense. We are a multi-Component unit staffed by Active Duty and Reserve Component Soldiers. Our mission is: when directed, 6th Medical Logistics Management Center (MLMC) deploys to provide centralized medical materiel and maintenance management to designated forces in order to sustain Geographical Combatant Command (GCC) Unified Land Operations (ULO) and Defense Support of Civil Authorities (DSCA). We perform this mission using split-based operations, i.e. forward teams deploy while the MLMC base operates from Fort Detrick, Maryland.
